Musculoskeletal System

The basic structure of a bone consists of a thin, superficial layer of compact bone overlying the bone marrow cavity composed of spongy bone. Since bone is a living tissue, it requires a neurovasculature supply. Arterial blood is provided by the nutrient, periosteal, metaphyseal, and epiphyseal arteries. Innervation reaches bones via periosteal nerves—these are the culprits for the sensation ...
